Application Procedure

Application forms and instructions can be found online at www.utoronto.ca/physical

Only online applications will be accepted.

The deadline for all award applications is **April 7, 2005**, unless otherwise specified. The award winners will be notified by mail after grades have been released.

Where financial need is a criterion the award winner must submit proof of OSAP eligibility by **October 31, 2005**. These awards are tenable in the 2005-06 academic year (i.e. September 2005 to May 2006). Successful candidates are strongly encouraged to write a note of thanks to the award donor(s).

Definition of Terms

Financial Need

If the award criteria include a financial need component, the primary assessment of need is OSAP eligibility. A copy of "Notice of Assessment" or your "OSAP Entitlement" from the OSAP web site (<http://osap.gov.on.ca>) must be provided as soon as it is available in order to confirm award eligibility. Ontario residency is required.

Academic Terms

Academic Excellence is considered by U of T to be an "A" average, AGPA of 3.50 and above

Academic Achievement is considered by U of T to be a "B" average, AGPA of 2.50 and above

Athletic Based Awards

Any award related to participation in Varsity sports falls under OUA and CIS league regulations. Stipulations include: a "B" average, a maximum award total of \$3500 per calendar year and completion of two academic terms at U of T. This information can also be found on the internet at: www.oua.ca or www.universitysport.ca.

While some awards give preference to candidates from a specific Varsity Blues team, such awards shall be open to candidates in other sports or programs if there is no clear recipient in the program specified.

Secondary school students entering 1st year BPHE program with an average of 90% or better and have not received any other admission scholarship. All candidates are considered, no special application.

THE JEAN FORSTER ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS..... \$3000

To be awarded to candidates entering first year on the basis of:

- Academic merit in the secondary school program
- An outstanding Statement of Interest
- The recipient's minimum overall admissions average in Ontario Grade 13/OAC or equivalent must be 85%. A candidate whose average falls below 85% may be awarded at the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty of Physical Education and Health.

DR. DONALD H.H. MACKENZIE BPHE ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP \$3000

To be awarded to candidates entering first year on the basis of:

All students in the BPHE program are considered for academic awards. To be eligible for a scholarship, a student must be carrying a full load of academic, activity and ODP courses for the year under consideration. No special application is necessary.

JURIV. DANIEL IN-COURSE SCHOLARSHIP\$150

To be awarded on the basis of:

- Academic excellence based on a full course load, (> 80%)
- Have not received any other scholarship
